Fees:

1. There is a hanging fee of £5.00 per framed picture exhibited including reserves and £3.00 unframed.
2. A commission of 20% will be retained by the Society on pictures which are sold.
3. Please bring cash or cheques (made payable to "Tetbury Art Society") to the hand-in at the Market House on Thursday 22nd August between 6pm - 7pm. Payment may also be made by BACS to Tetbury Art Society, Lloyds Bank, Sort Code 30-92-06., Account No 01576966. If paying by BACS, please use the reference **TAS-exhib** so that the treasurer will know who has paid.

Please Note

Unsold Pictures must be collected immediately the exhibition finishes on the last day. There are no storage facilities at the Market Hall for uncollected work, nor for extra pictures. Once commission has been deducted from a sale a cheque or BACS payment will be posted to you by the Treasurer. Please do not cause an obstruction by the Market Hall with your car.

The attached Entry Form, together with your availability for stewarding, must be completed and returned to Anne Weston no later than Friday 9th August 2024, preferably by email, see above.

We aim to present new work to the public at every exhibition however, the Summer exhibition can include 50% of previous work.
